Consult with dental professionals whom you trust. Dental and medical specialists (oral surgeons, orthodontists, endodontists, and plastic surgeons) see lots of dentistry from many different offices. They are in a keen position to tell you who does the best work.



Browse websites of dentists recommended to you. It's important to review examples of their work. Make certain you like what you see and the images are not stock photographs but actual before and after images of patients treated in the practice.



Search the Academy of Cosmetic Dentistry's web site for a credentialed dentist in your area (www.aacd.com). The AACD accredits (certifies) dentists in cosmetic dentistry. To become Accredited, dentists must complete a demanding testing process, including: a written exam; documentation of five specific types of clinical cases (with before and after treatment photographs); participation in continuing education classes; and passing a final oral exam.



Other organizations, such as The Kois Center and the American Academy of Esthetic Dentistry also stress advanced education and high ethical standards.



The key point is that even though cosmetic dentistry is not recognized as a specialty, it is important to seek a dentist that approaches it as if it is. A doctor's continuing education, organizational memberships and credentials all highlight areas of interest and expertise and are important to consider when making a decision.

### TO SUM IT UP

While every dentist is a health professional, some dentists are more interested, knowledgeable, experienced and artistic when it comes to cosmetic dentistry. More complex issues will definitely require a greater degree of expertise in engineering the bite and managing the original sources of breakdown. The more extensive the work, the greater skill level required to assure long term success.

When it comes to cosmetic dentistry, or any dentistry for that matter, the goal is health and predictable, beautiful results. This is an achievable outcome as long as you have the right cosmetic dentist by your side.
